

# Frequently Asked Questions

## 1. Which employees need the Hazardous Material & Security Awareness training?

- a. Anyone who loads, unloads or handles hazardous materials
- b. Anyone who inspects, repairs or maintains containers for hazardous materials
- c. Anyone who has responsibility for the safe handling or transporting of hazardous materials
- d. Anyone who operates a vehicle transporting hazardous materials

## 2. How often are employees required to take this course?

Training is required every three (3) years. New employees must be trained within 90 days of hiring.

## 3. Where and when is training offered?

The Tennessee Fuel & Convenience Store Association now offers its HazMat training online and on demand. You now have a choice of where and when to receive training.

The course is 90 minutes long. You may view the training as a group or on an individual basis.

## 4. How do we register?

The course is available to employees of TFCA member companies.

A designated company representative should complete the registration form and submit payment for all individuals requiring certification.

Once the registration form and payment is received, the TFCA office will email the designated company representative a link to online training and the three required exams.

Individuals must view the training, complete the exams and return the tests to the designated company representative.

Completed exams must be submitted to the TFCA office as proof of completion of the course. The exams will not be graded.

Certificates of completion will be mailed to the designated company representative.
